

Glanbia uses Olas software to train Worldwide SAP HR Users

Glanbia abandons the classroom to achieve consistent worldwide SAP ESS training.

1 February 2010: Glanbia plc, a leading Irish cheese and nutritional ingredients group with operations in Ireland, Europe, USA and China, has teamed with Olas to use Assima Training Suite of tools to revolutionise how they train their dispersed global employees on SAP.

Although an early adopter that benefited from SAP for over a decade, Glanbia now had the seemingly conflicting requirements of improving the consistency of user training on new SAP modules, but to reduce the amount time and effort employees spent attending training.

The solution was to use system cloning training tools from Olas' parent Assima plc. The tools enabled the Ireland-based training team to create self-service e-learning based on Assima's lifelike system-cloning technology.
